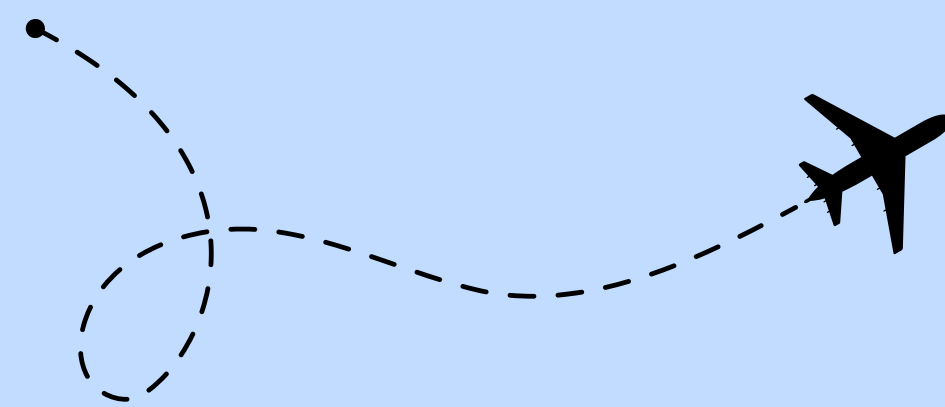

How to get to Toronto

- **Best Option:** Direct flight to Toronto Pearson Airport
 - UP Express Train from Toronto Pearson Airport to Union Station (\$12.35 CAD)
 - Taxi/Uber from Union Station to Chelsea Hotel (\$10-15 CAD)
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- **Second Option:** Billy Bishop Airport
 - Taxi/Uber to The Chelsea Hotel (\$17-20 CAD)



Getting to the Venue: Ted Rogers School of Management



From Union Station

- Taxi/Uber (\$10-15 CAD)
- Subway (\$3.40 CAD)
 - Travel northbound on Line 1 (Yonge-University) for around 4 minutes and get off at Dundas Station
 - Exit the train, follow the station signs directly to Yonge-Dundas Square



From The Chelsea Hotel

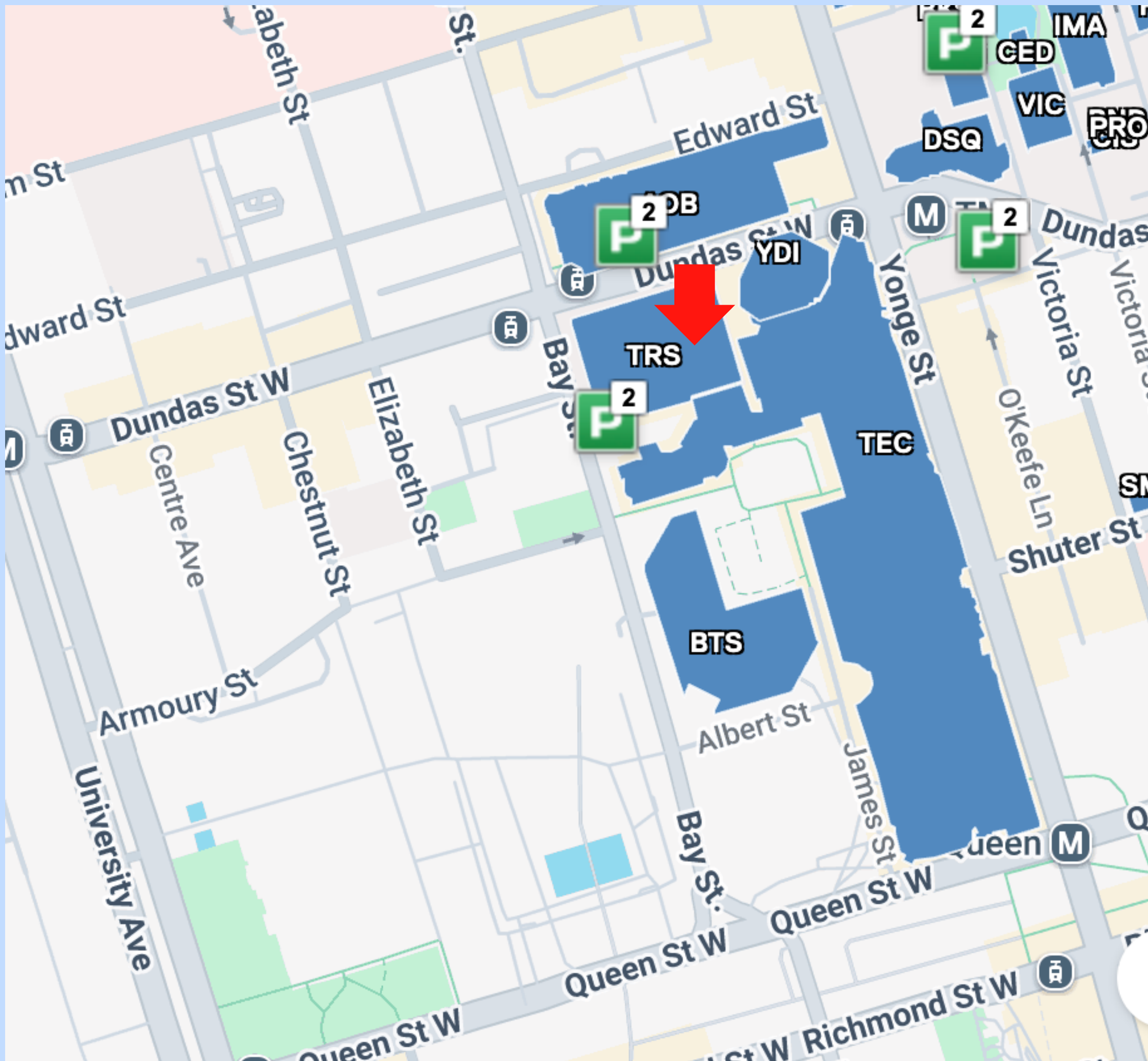
- 6-minute walk

The venue is on the south side of Dundas Street with its main entrance mid-way between Bay St. and Yonge St. (besides Joey's Restaurant)

PLEASE NOTE: This building remains locked at all times. Upon arrival, you will be greeted and guided to the 7th floor.

Inside of the Venue

Enter the building at the doors located beside the restaurant, Joey's.

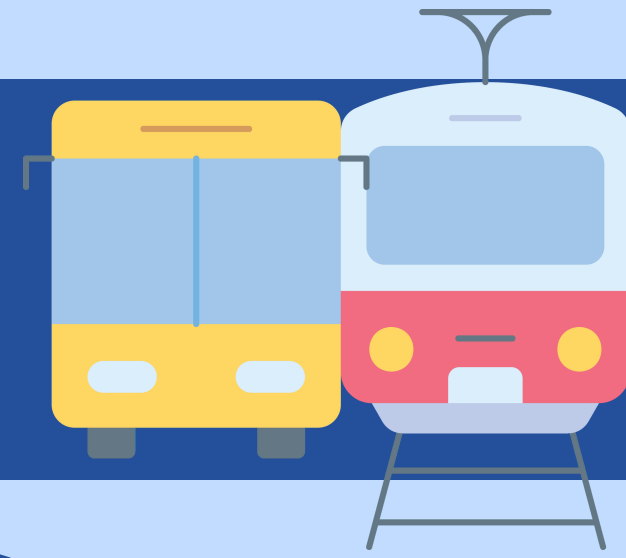


On the ground floor, take the elevators to the 7th floor

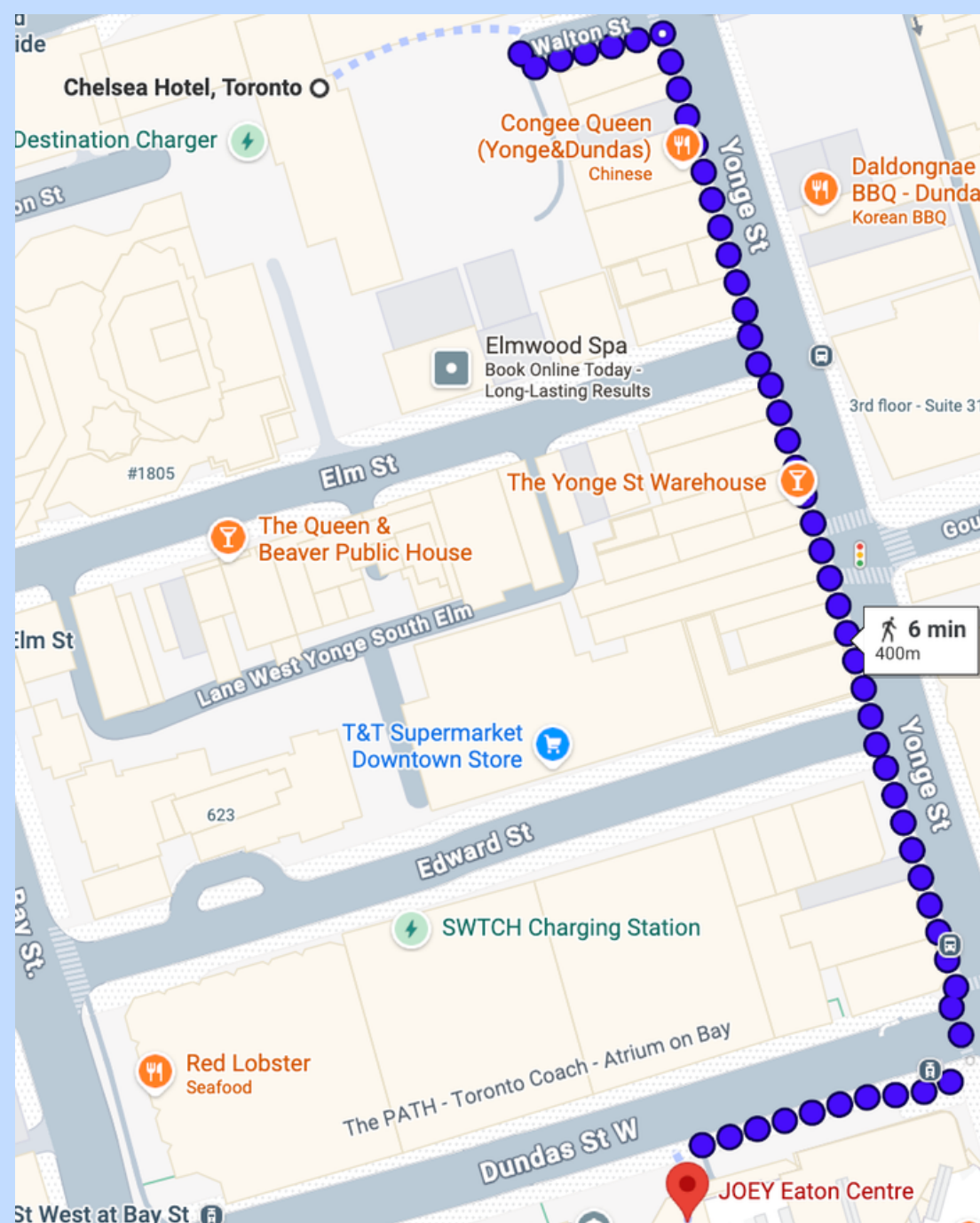
From the Venue

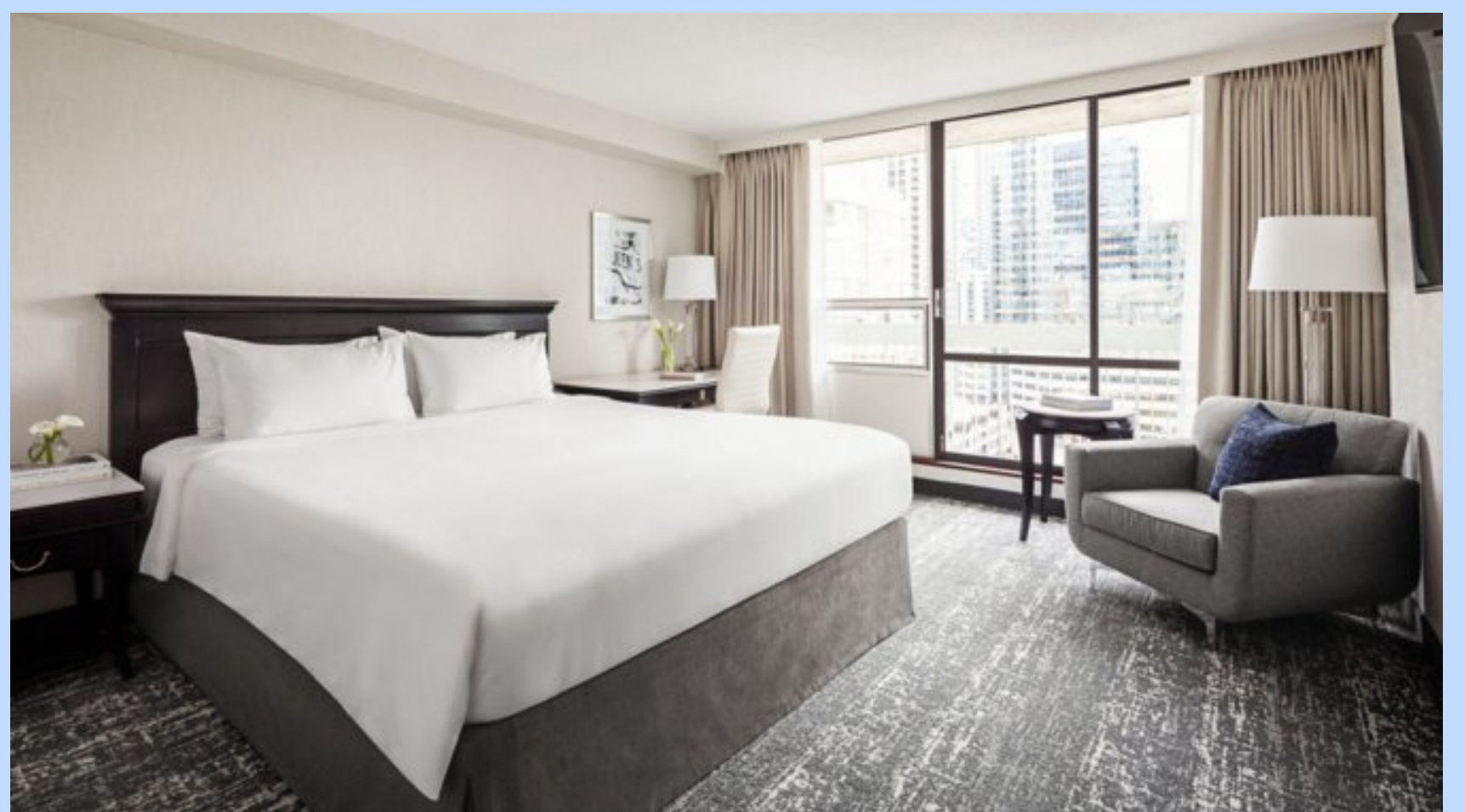

Top Tourist Attractions in Toronto



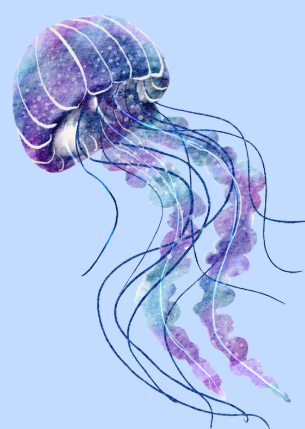
CN Tower
